## Registration/Tuition

## What We Are About?

The AllStars Recreational teams are for dancers who are new to dance and want to compete or who do not have the time to commit to the competitive team. Most of all though, it is for any student who wants to have FUN!

It is the staff's goal to provide a positive learning environment that teaches our dancers the skills they need to not only compete on stage, but to truly perform.

As a way to foster friendships, team members are paired with other dancers on their team. These pairs are AllStar siblings. They are encouraged to spend time together at competitions and make or buy "good luck" gifts for each other.

## Class Requirements

Recreational team members are required to attend their weekly team rehearsal(s). These rehearsals are 45 minutes long and take place on week day evenings.

Additionally, team members may take technique class that will help them improve their technique. All these classes are offered at the Miracle Dance Theatre. Please see the back cover of this brochure for a schedule of teams and classes.

## Time Commitments

The season begins in September when we enroll for classes. Regular rehearsals/ classes continue from September to February. March may require extra rehearsals. Attendance is very important. Please make sure you let your instructor know if you are going to be missing.

Excessive absences may result in removal from the team.

The recreation teams will attend two competitions between March and May. Competitions require you to be available to perform on either a Saturday or Sunday (exact times are not known until ONE week prior to the competition). Team members will also perform in our Showcase in June.

## Team Warm-Ups

Team members are required to purchase a team warm-up which consists of a light jacket and pants embroidered with the team logo and the dancers' name. These can be purchased at the studio in September. The cost of the warm-up is \$80. Dancers are encouraged to wear their warm-ups to rehearsals and are required to wear them at competitions.

## Tuition and Fees

All tuition and fees are paid to the studio. For a list of tuition amounts, please see the back cover.

You will receive a detailed statement that will include all fees the first of each month. Payments are late after the 10th of the month and will be charged a late fee. If your account is not paid to date prior to a competition, your child will not be entered in that competition.

The cost for Recreational teams is kept to a minimum. These fees will also be reflected on your monthly statement. Fees include:

- Costumes \$60 - \$80 per costume
- Entry Fees \$15 - \$30 per routine per competition

## To Become a Member

Auditions are not required to join a Recreational team. Interested students may join by registering for the team like a class. October 31st is the cutoff date for Recreational Team registration.

Being part of the team requires hard work and dedication. Students not putting forth a certain level of effort will be asked to work harder. In rare cases, students may be removed from the team and placed in a regular class to gain experience and asked to try the team again next year. This decision will be made no later than November 30th.
